- ❖ Identified and adapted to students demographic's needs and learning environment by creating projects that ensure student success
 - Promoted a positive and creative classroom environment by utilizing and reinforcing Studio & Classroom Expectations and Artist Mindset
- ❖ Reviewed foundational art concepts and skills on color theory with 4 Multimedia Studio classes through vocabulary and hands-on activities: note-taking presentation, Kahoot, painted a color wheel value scale, and created portraits with acrylic paint
- ❖ Communicated with guardians via email and phone calls to inform what their students were working on in class, and to address recurring disruptive or concerning behavior
- ❖ Key Achievement: Three (out of four) classes maintained a B (80-85%) grade average on their final art project
